

My Place of Praise

The Lord is good and His mercy endures forever!

Bless the Lord O my soul. And all that is within me
bless His Holy Name. Bless the Lord O my soul,
and forget not all your benefits; Who pardons all
your iniquities, Who heals all your diseases; Who
redeems your life from the pits, Who crowns you
with lovingkindness and compassion; Who satisfies
your years with good things, so that your youth is
renewed like the eagle. (Ps. 103:1-5)

Is anyone among you afflicted...He should pray. Is
anyone glad at heart? He should sing praise [to
God]. (James 5:13) **Praised** (honored, blessed) be the
God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ (the
Messiah)! By His boundless mercy we have been
born again to an ever-living hope through the
resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, (1 Peter 1:3)

Although I am in pain *right now* and *in* distress; *I*
know Your salvation, O God, *will* protect me. *I*
praise Your name in song and *I* glorify You with
thanksgiving. This will please *You Oh my LORD*,
more than an ox, more than a bull with its horns and
hoofs. (Ps. 69:29-31 NIV)

...we who first hoped in Christ [who first put our
confidence in Him have been destined and
appointed to] live for the praise of His glory!
(Ephesians 1:12) No unbelief or distrust *will make me*
waver or doubtfully question concerning the
promise of God, but *I grow* strong and *am*
empowered by faith as *I give* praise and glory to
God, (Romans 4:20)

...blessing *and praise* be to the God and Father of
our Lord Jesus Christ (the Messiah) Who has
blessed *me* in Christ with every spiritual blessing
(*given by the Holy Spirit*) in the heavenly realm!

(Ephesians 1:3) *I call out!* Heal me, O Lord, and I shall be healed; save me, and I shall be saved, for You are my praise. (Jeremiah 17:14)

O Lord, You said! Behold, at that time I will deal with all those who afflict you; I will save the limping [ones] and gather the outcasts and will make them a praise and a name in every land of their shame. (Zephaniah 3:19) *And, You said!* At that time I will bring you in; yes, at that time I will gather you, for I will make you a name and a praise among all the nations of the earth when I reverse your captivity before your eyes, says the Lord. (Zephaniah 3:20) *Therefore, I declare, I am released from the captivity of this affliction and every cancer infected cell is cleansed in Jesus' mighty name! AMEN*

...blessed, praised, and glorified be God Most High, Who has given *my* foes into *my* hand! (Genesis 14:20)

I call on the Lord, Who is worthy to be praised, and I am saved from my enemies. (2 Samuel 22:4) For this I will give thanks and extol You, O Lord, among the nations; I will sing praises to Your name. (2 Samuel 22:50); and, *I say*, "Praise be to the LORD, the God of -- Abraham, who has not abandoned his kindness and faithfulness *toward me*... (Genesis 24:27)

My LORD You are my strength and my song; *You have* become my salvation. *You are* my God, and I praise *You*, my father's God, and I exalt *You*. (Exodus 15:2) ... "Praise be to the LORD, who rescued *me*... (Exodus 18:10)

...*You* grant [consolation and joy] to those who mourn in Zion...*You* give them an ornament (a garland or diadem) of beauty instead of ashes, the oil of joy instead of mourning, the garment [expressive] of praise instead of a heavy, burdened, and failing spirit...that they may be called oaks of

righteousness [lofty, strong, and magnificent, distinguished for uprightness, justice, and right standing with God], the planting of the Lord, that He may be glorified. (Isaiah 61:3)

Though *I fall*, *I* shall not be utterly cast down, for the Lord grasps his hand in support and upholds *me*. (Psalm 37:24) The Lord is ready to save (deliver) me; therefore *I* will sing songs of *praise*... all the days of my life in the house of the Lord. (Isaiah 38:18-20)

Why are you cast down, O my inner self? And why should you moan over me and be disquieted within me? Hope in God and wait expectantly for Him, for I shall yet praise Him, my Help and my God. (Psalm 42:5) I sing to Him, I sing praises to Him; *I* meditate on and talk of all His wondrous works and devoutly praise them! (1 Chronicles 16:9)

For Sheol (the place of the dead) cannot confess and reach out the hand to You, death cannot praise and rejoice in You; those who go down to the pit cannot hope for Your faithfulness [to Your promises; their probation is at an end, their destiny is sealed]. *Only* the living, the living--they shall thank and praise You, as I do this day; *I* shall make known to *my children and my children's children* Your faithfulness and Your truth. (Isaiah 38:18-20)

For My name's sake, *says the Lord*, I defer My anger, and for the sake of My praise I restrain it for you, that I may not cut you off. (Isaiah 48:9) AMEN! *Yes Lord, for Your name sake and the sake of Your praise I shall not be cut off.* For the Lord will comfort *me*; He will comfort all *my* waste places. And He will make *my* wilderness like Eden, and *my* desert like the garden of the Lord. Joy and gladness will be found in *me*, thanksgiving and the voice of song or instrument of praise. (Isaiah 51:3)

Who shall not reverence and glorify Your name, O Lord [giving You honor and praise in worship]? For You only are holy. All the nations shall come and pay homage and adoration to You... (Revelation 15:4) I will give to the Lord the thanks due to His rightness and justice, and I will sing praise to the name of the Lord Most High. (Psalm 7:17)

I WILL praise You, O Lord, with my whole heart; I will show forth (recount and tell aloud) all Your marvelous works and wonderful deeds! (Psalm 9:1) *I rejoice in You and remain in high spirits; Today and always I sing praise to Your name, O Lord Most High!* (Psalm 9:2) *I sing praises to the Lord, Who dwells in Zion! I declare among the peoples His doings!* (Psalm 9:11) *I sing praises to the Lord, for He has done excellent things [gloriously]; let this be made known to all the earth.* (Isaiah 12:5)

O LORD, You are my God; I will exalt You, I will praise Your name, for You have done wonderful things, even purposes planned of old [and fulfilled] in faithfulness and truth. (Isaiah 25:1-3)

You Are the Lord; that is Your name! And Your glory You will not give to another, nor Your praise to graven images. (Isaiah 42:8) *Therefore, I will praise You all the days of my life. Amen.*

I sing to the Lord a new song, and His praise from the end of the earth! (Isaiah 42:10). *I give glory to the Lord and declare His praise* (Isaiah 42:12)

I will recount the loving-kindnesses of the Lord and the praiseworthy deeds of the Lord.... (Isaiah 63:7) *I sing to the Lord! Praise the Lord! For He has delivered the life of the poor and needy from the hands of evildoers.* (Jeremiah 20:13)

[There shall be heard again] the voice of joy and the voice of gladness, the voice of the bridegroom and the voice of the bride, the voices of those who sing as they bring sacrifices of thanksgiving into the house of the Lord, Give praise and thanks to the Lord of hosts, for the Lord is good; for His mercy and kindness and steadfast love endure forever! For *the Lord says*, I will cause the captivity of the land to be reversed and return to be as it was at first, says the Lord. (Jeremiah 33:11)

I thank You and praise You, O God...Who has given me wisdom and might and has made known to me now what *I* desired of *Him*, for *He has* made known to *me* the solution (Daniel 2:23) And *He said* *I shall eat in plenty and be satisfied and praise the name of the Lord, my God, Who has dealt wondrously with me. And My family shall never be put to shame.* (Joel 2:26)

May *I* abound in and be filled with the fruits of righteousness (of right standing with God and right doing) which come through Jesus Christ (the Anointed One), to the honor and praise of God [that His glory may be both manifested and recognized]. (Philippians 1:11)

... I shall not *be disgraced* nor be put to shame in anything; but that with the utmost freedom of speech and unflinching courage... Christ (the Messiah) will be magnified and get glory and praise in this body of mine and *He will* be boldly exalted in my person, whether through (by) life or through (by) death. (Philippians 1:20)

... whatever is true, whatever is worthy of reverence and is honorable and seemly, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely and lovable, whatever is kind and winsome and gracious, if there is any virtue and excellence, if

there is anything worthy of praise, *I* think on and weigh and take account of these things [*I* fix *my* mind on them]. (Philippians 4:8)

And, ...the peace...from Christ rule...in *my* heart... [deciding and settling with finality all questions that arise in *my* mind, *I am* in a peaceful state]. *The peace from Christ*, to which as [member of Christ's] one body *I am* also called [to live]. And *I am* thankful (appreciative), [giving praise to God always]. (Colossians 3:15)

Through Him, therefore, *I* constantly and at all times offer up to God a sacrifice of praise...*confessing* and *glorifying* His name. (Hebrews 13:15)

Then from the throne there came a voice, saying, Praise our God, all you servants of His, you who reverence Him, both small and great! (Revelation 19:5). *I praise You! Oh Lord my God!*

After that I heard what sounded like the shout of a vast throng, like the boom of many pounding waves, and like the roar of terrific and mighty peals of thunder, exclaiming, **Hallelujah (praise the Lord)! For now the Lord our God the Omnipotent (the All-Ruler) reigns!** (Revelation 19:6)

You reign in me Oh Lord my God. *Cancer does not reign in me! In the Mighty name of Jesus Christ my redeemer and healer!* Lord, I am who I am because of Who You are in me. I overcome!
